

United States Army Military Working Dogs that served in Thailand - 1974

**Dogs of the 7th Radio Research Field Site (RRFS) Ramasun, Thailand - U. S. Army**

On March 14, 1974 a very large number of Military Working Dogs were shipped from the PACAF Okinawa Dog Center to Udorn Royal Thai Air Base, Thailand. It is believed that the dogs were staged at Udorn RTAB, Thailand, then transferred to the 7th Radio Research Field Site (RRFS) Ramasun, Thailand. Military Working Dog records indicate that they arrived in mid March and were transferred to the U. S. Army Security Agency facility, Ramasun, to ramp up a Military Police K-9 section to secure that facility on April 5, 1974.
