Membership

VDHA membership is comprised of dog handlers from Vietnam, Korea, World war II, Desert Storm , Iraq, many other conflicts for which a Combat Ribbon was awarded, non-combat dog handlers and civilians with a keen interest in the history and future of Americas Military Dog Program. It is a veteran's organization with a real sense of family, offering both validation and closure to handlers whose service (and sacrifice) enabled the safe return of many thousands of soldiers at war's end.

Membership is divided into 2 Categories:

- **Member (Voting)** - Is open to all veterans / military personnel who have served or are currently serving as a Dog Handler, Veterinarian, Vet Tech, Visual or Combat Tracker team member in a war/conflict combat zone for which a Combat Ribbon was/is awarded. With voting rights the member is eligible to hold office in the organization.
- **Associate (Non Voting)** - Is open to all Military Dog Handlers past or present who have handled a dog or are currently handling a dog in peace time or War/conflict in an area for which a Combat Ribbon IS/WAS NOT AWARDED ,to all other Military Veterans—their families and Civilian Personnel with a keen interest in dogs.
